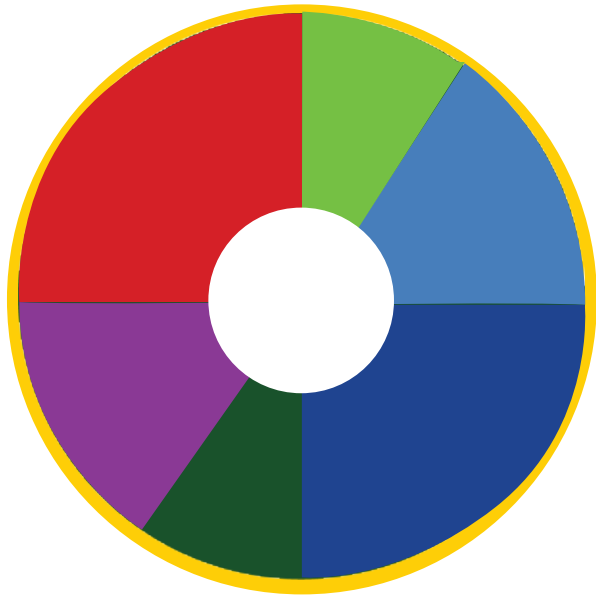

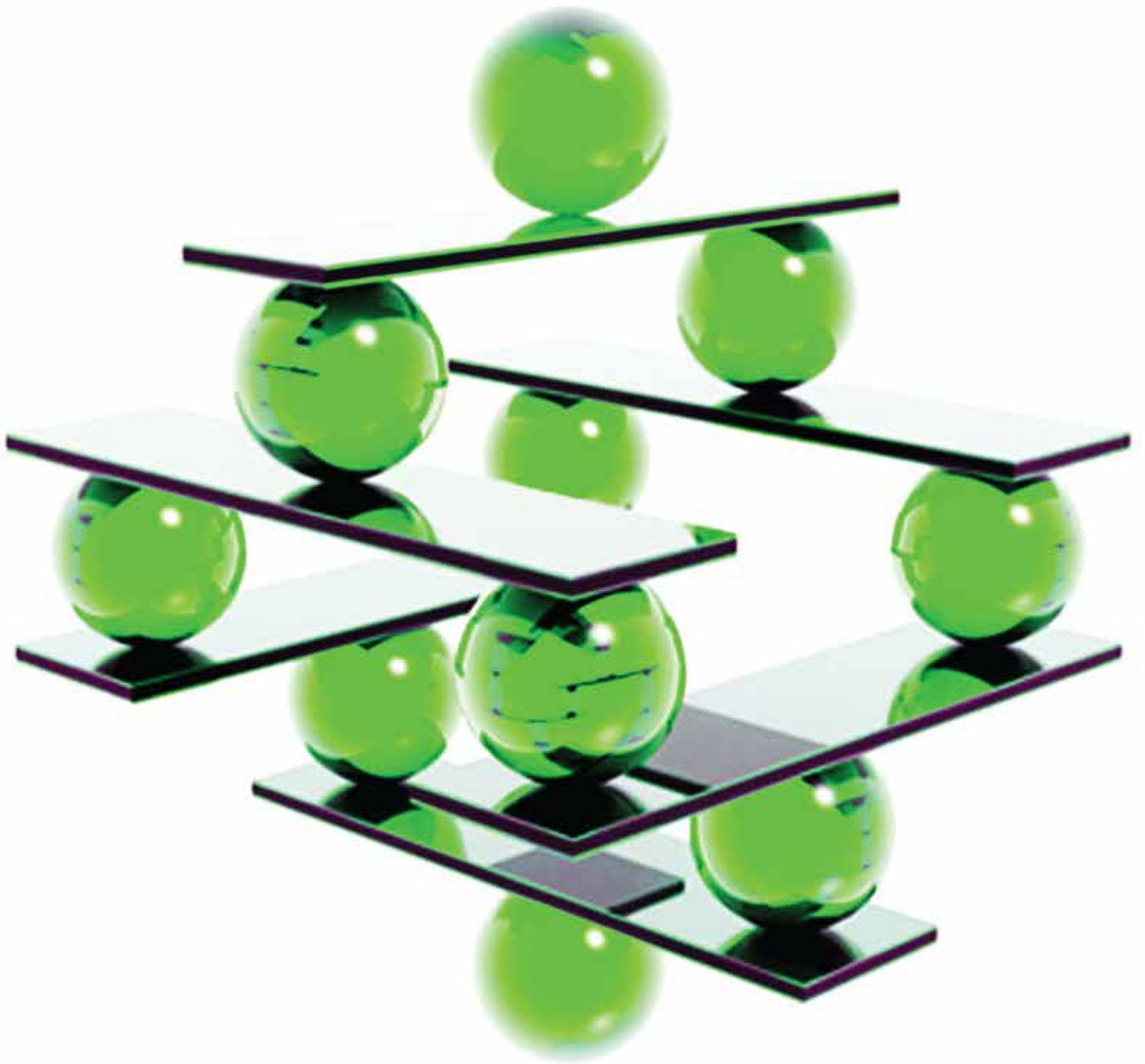

He has won several awards which include : The Defence Service Medal (DSM), Forces Services Star (FSS Freedom of the City of Harare, Zimbabwe was conferred on Babangida on 19 July 1989 by President Robert Mugabe, General Service Medal (GSM), Grand Commander of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (GCFR), Grand Gordon in the Meritorious Order of International Military Sports Council, awarded to Babangida, Knight Grand Cross of the Bath (KGCB) was conferred on Babangida in May 1989, by Queen Elizabeth II of Britain, National Service Medal (NSM), Royal Service Medal (RSM) to name but a few. He is a leader passionate about Youth Empowerment through Entrepreneurship development, leading to National Productivity.

HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY, OBA (DR.) FREDERICK ENITOLORUNDA OBATERU AKINRUNTAN *(Okoro Ajiga 1). Olugbo of Ugboland*

He is the traditional ruler of Ugbol Kingdom, a town in Ilaje Local Government, Ondo State, Southwestern Nigeria. He is an Oil magnate and Founder of Obat Oil, one of Nigeria's largest and leading privately held oil companies in Nigeria which he founded in 1981. Today, the company has more than 50 gas stations across the six geopolitical zones of Nigeria and the company owns one of the largest tank farms in Africa, a modern storage facility able to store 65 million liters of petroleum products.

He is a topmost philanthropist transforming lives by providing free medical services and empowerment through the OBA AKINRUNTAN FOUNDATION to further better the lives of his subjects and Nigerians as a whole.

Murtala Nyako has been a recipient of an honorary Doctorate Degree of Agriculture from the University of Agriculture, Abeokuta; University of Technology Minna, University of Technology, Yola and the National Awards of Commander of Federal Republic (CFR), Grand Commander of the Niger (GCON) and another Commander of the Federal Republic (CFR) in 2002.

Chief (Mrs) Alaba Lawson, the Iyalode of Yorubaland is the first female President of Nigeria Association of Chambers of Commerce, Industry, Mines and Agriculture (NACCIMA), the proprietor of Lawson's Group of Schools, the Chairman Board of Governing Council, Moshood Abiola Polytechnic and the chairman of Abestone Microfinance Bank.

She obtained a First Class Diploma in Education at St. Nicholas Montessori Teachers' Training College at Prince's Gate, England. An astute educationist and entrepreneur, she has pioneered several businesses such as a trading/distributing firm known as Capricorn Stores Ltd, a Microfinance Bank known as Abestone Microfinance Bank to boost SMES and the renowned Lawson Group of Schools.

She also served as President of the Abeokuta Chambers Of Commerce, the Ogun Council of Chambers, and the Odu'a Chamber of Commerce.

Without any equivocation, Iyalode Alaba Lawson's strongest point however is in the area of Philanthropy especially as it concerns the grass-root and the underprivileged. As a demonstration of her passion for academic excellence and economic empowerment, she awards scholarships to indigent but brilliant students on a yearly basis.
